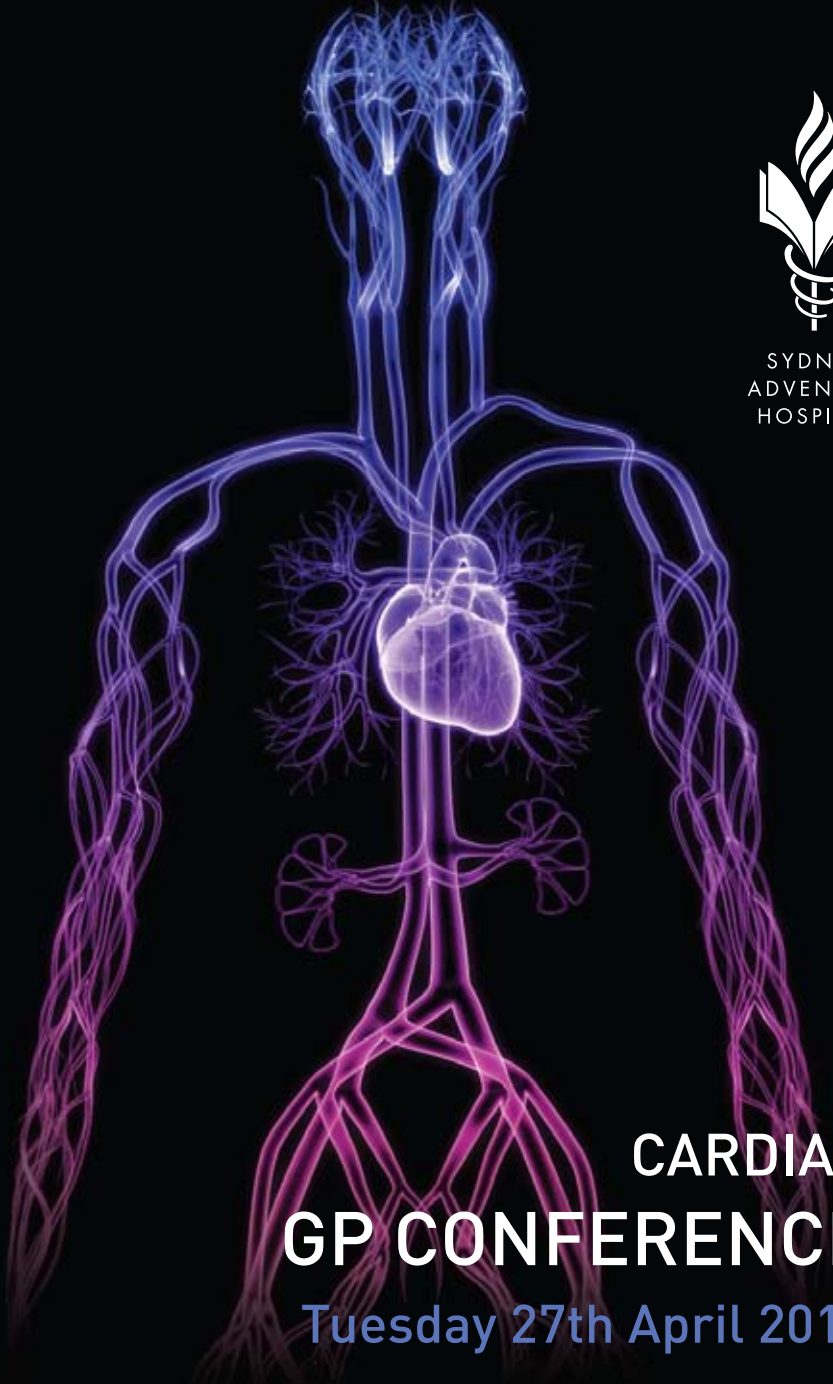

CORONARY ARTERY DISEASE – DIAGNOSIS & MANAGEMENT

Dr Christopher Flood BMedSc, MBBS (Hons), FRACP

Description: You will learn about the diagnosis and management of acute coronary syndrome and the implications of hospital treatment on subsequent patient management in the general practice setting. You will also learn what guidelines should be used in GP Practice to refer appropriate patients to Cardiac Rehabilitation.

Dr Christopher Flood is a Consultant Cardiologist at the San and graduated from the University of Tasmania in 1995. After completion of advanced training in cardiology he was appointed Interventional Fellow in Cardiology at Prince of Wales Hospital. He has a particular interest in chest pain, severe coronary artery disease, preventative cardiac care and echocardiography. Dr Flood has rooms at Westmead, Castle Hill, Blacktown and Sydney Adventist Hospital.

PULMONARY OEDEMA & CARDIAC FAILURE – DIAGNOSIS & MANAGEMENT

Dr Graham Tanswell MBBS, FRACP, FCSANZ

Description: You will learn about the diagnosis and management of pulmonary oedema and cardiac failure including contemporary management and treatment options and the General Practitioner's role in management of these patients.

Dr Graham Tanswell completed university training at the University of New South Wales in 1990. He undertook his residency at Westmead Hospital, where he completed his Cardiology Specialty training in 1998. Since 1999 he has been in private practice, with specific interests in arrhythmia and electrophysiology, cardiac catheterisation, echocardiography, and general adult cardiology. He is a member of the Heart Rhythm Society and the Cardiac Society of Australia and New Zealand.

HOME MONITORING OF IMPLANTABLE PACEMAKER & DEFIBRILLATOR DEVICES

Dr Peter Illes MBBCh, DCH (SA), FCP (SA), FRACP

Description: You will learn about the types of devices and technology for home monitoring including advantages & disadvantages, safety, ethics, and future directions. You will also learn about how the technology can enhance patient care and gain an understanding of which patients would benefit from this intensive device follow up.

Dr Peter Illes attends the San and Mater Hospitals. He graduated in Johannesburg in 1980 and trained in internal medicine at the University of Capetown. He then undertook training in Cardiology at the University of Newcastle upon Tyne. He is currently in private practice. Dr Illes' special interests are device implantation including management and monitoring, heart failure and all aspects of interventional and diagnostic cardiology.
