Dr William Sears

Description: You will learn how this Nobel Prize-winning detection technology will enhance diagnostic accuracy and improve surgical outcomes in patients with spinal deformities and at a fraction of the radiation dose of conventional x-ray techniques.

Dr William Sears is a graduate of Sydney University and completed his neurosurgical training at Royal North Shore Hospital. He sub-specialises exclusively in the field of spinal disorders with research interests in adult degenerative deformity and spinal motion preservation technology. He is an author of 23 manuscripts in peer-reviewed journals and has given over 100 podium presentations at National and International Neurosurgical and Spine Meetings. Dr Sears currently consults at Dalcross Adventist Hospital.

Description: You will learn about coeliac serology screening including how to identify when a coeliac serology screen should be requested, how to interpret the results, follow up testing and diagnosis of Coeliac Disease.

Michelle is currently employed by San Pathology at Sydney Adventist Hospital and has a special interest in the genetic basis of Cancer, Stem Cell therapy, cord blood and Molecular Diagnostics.
