THE UNCONSCIOUS PATIENT

Dr Greg McDonald MBBS, FACEM

Description: You will learn about the different diagnoses of a reduced level of consciousness and about an algorithmic approach to assessment and stabilisation of an unconscious patient. You will also observe a practical demonstration of the management of an unconscious patient.

Dr Greg McDonald is Director of Emergency Care at Sydney Adventist Hospital. He completed his Emergency Medicine training at Royal North Shore and Gosford hospitals and gained his Fellowship in Emergency Medicine in 1988. He has been Director of Emergency Care at Sydney Adventist Hospital since 1995 and has a special interest in GP and student education in Toxinology

THE CHILD WITH A LIMP

Dr Jeffrey Chaitow MBBCh, FRACP

Description: You will learn about the difference between mechanical and inflammatory joint pain and how to avoid over-investigation of benign limb pains. You will also learn a working approach to the management of juvenile arthritis.

Dr Jeffrey Chaitow is currently Chairman of the Department of Paediatrics at Sydney Adventist Hospital, and Head of the Department of Rheumatology at The Children's Hospital at Westmead. His sub-specialty within General Paediatrics is Paediatric Rheumatology, seeing children with musculo-skeletal problems and autoimmune inflammatory disease such as Juvenile Arthritis and Systemic Lupus Erythematosus.

DEVELOPMENTAL DELAY IN CHILDREN – IS THIS AN EMERGENCY?

Dr Neil Ginsberg MBBCh, FRACP, M Med (Paeds)

Description: You will learn about common developmental milestones in children and how to recognise patients that are not meeting milestones. You will also learn about the appropriate referral pathways for dealing with suspected delays in children.

Dr Neil Ginsberg graduated from the University of Witwatersrand in 1985. After a period in General Practice, he trained in Paediatrics in Johannesburg and completed his specialty training in 1991 before graduating as Master of Medicine in Paediatrics. Dr Ginsberg obtained his FRACP in 1996 and was a Fellow in Neonatology at Royal North Shore Hospital in 1996 before becoming a consultant at Westmead Hospital in 1997. He began his private practice in 1997 in Wahroonga, Baulkham Hills and Westmead, and has a special interest in the management of the newborn, paediatric respiratory disease, and general paediatrics.
