## WOUND CARE AND ANTIBIOTIC PROPHYLAXIS

**Dr Greg McDonald** MBBS, FACEM

**Description:** You will learn about basic wound care principles, antibiotic prophylaxis for specific wounds and management of skin infections.

Dr Sherlock has a particular interest in sports injuries, arthroscopic and joint replacement surgery of the shoulder.
