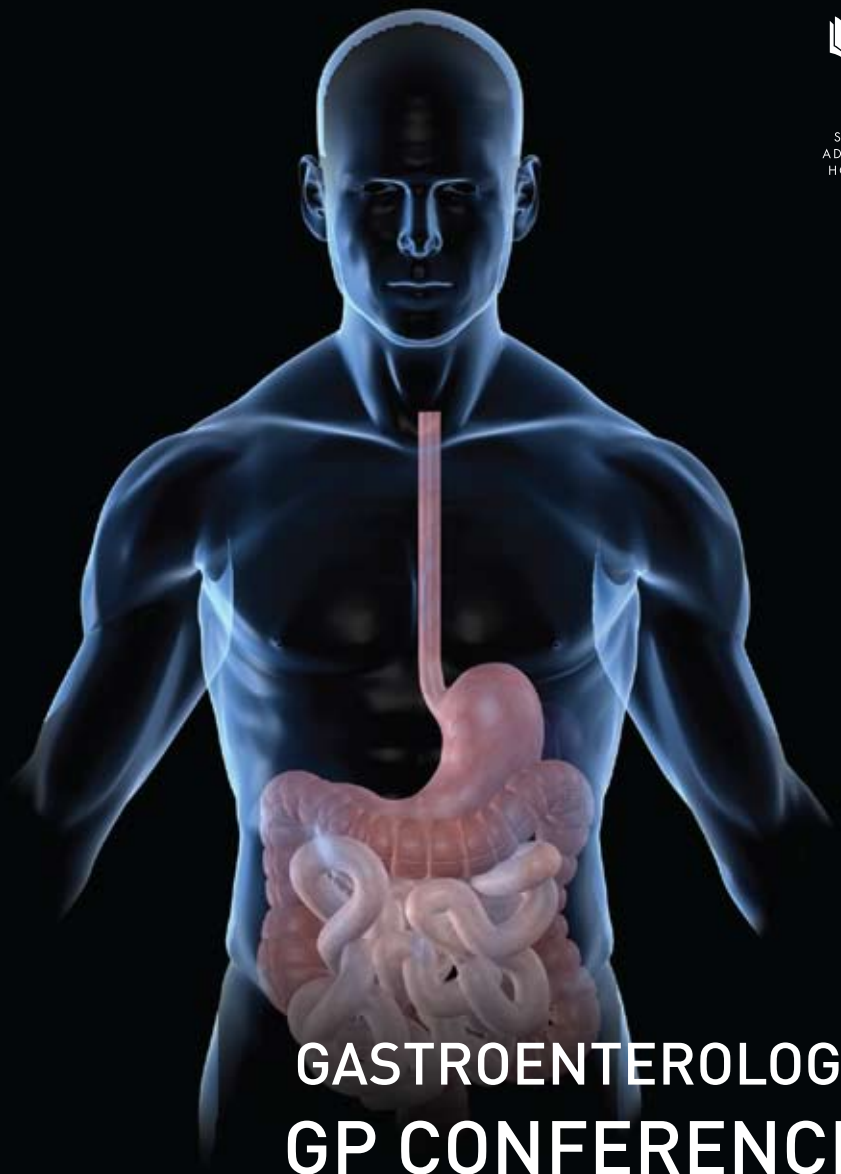

BARRETT'S AND OESOPHAGEAL CANCER – ANOTHER CASUALTY OF THE OBESITY EPIDEMIC

Professor Brian Jones MBBS, MD, FRACP, FRCP (Lond.), FACP

Description: You will learn the definition of and risk factors for Barrett's Oesophagus. You will also learn about the pathogenesis of oesophageal cancer and management options for Barrett's and Dysplasia.

Professor Brian Jones graduated from the University of London at St. Mary's Hospital and completed postgraduate physician and gastroenterology training in London, Cardiff, Melbourne, Canada and the USA. He is currently a Clinical Associate Professor at the University of Sydney, Head of the Department of Gastroenterology and Hepatology at Concord Hospital, and Senior Visiting Medical Officer at Concord Hospital and Sydney Adventist Hospital. Prof. Jones has a special interest in endoscopic ultrasound, and training in gastroenterology.

COELIAC DISEASE

Dr Chhaya Tangirala MBBS, FRACGP, FRACP

Description: You will learn about the presentation of coeliac disease and latent coeliac disease and how to recognise and treat its complications. You will also learn about its management including interpretation of serological and genetic tests, the biopsy result, treatment and the follow up of patients.

Dr Chhaya Tangirala undertook her advanced training at Liverpool, St George and Hornsby Hospitals and currently attends Castle Hill, Norwest Private, Ryde Public and Sydney Adventist Hospitals. She has a special interest in endoscopy, colonoscopy and hepatology.

ADVANCES IN ENDOSCOPY: ENDOSCOPIC THERAPY FOR MUCOSAL NEOPLASIA

Dr Michael Bourke MBBS, FRACP

Description: You will learn about the different types of superficial neoplasia of the gastrointestinal tract and the treatment options as indicated by pathology. You will also learn about appropriate follow up for patients with mucosal neoplasia.

Dr Michael Bourke graduated from Queensland University and obtained his FRACP before completing a fellowship in advanced therapeutic endoscopy in Toronto, Canada. He is the Director of Endoscopy at Westmead Hospital and also attends Sydney Adventist Hospital. He is widely published and has been an invited lecturer and faculty member at national and international gastroenterology meetings and endoscopy workshops. Dr Bourke's areas of interest and research include pancreaticobiliary endoscopy, gastrointestinal bleeding, complex polypectomy and endoscopic palliation of malignancy
