## LUNG CANCER

**Dr Pirooz Poursoltan, MD, MSc(Med), FRACP**

**Description:** You will learn about the screening and primary investigations of Lung Cancer, principals of staging and multidisciplinary treatment, novel treatments and risk reduction.

**Dr Pirooz Poursoltan** is a medical oncologist with a research background in the molecular biology of lung cancer at the Garvan Institute. He completed his Medical Doctorate Degree at Tehran University in Iran before completing a Master of Science degree from the University of Sydney and has a fellowship in clinical genetics. He has interests in lung and gastrointestinal malignancies and applications of new targeted therapies in their treatment.
