TITLE: PROSTATE CANCER

Dr Philip Bergersen MBBS, FRACS(Urol)

Description: You will learn about the diagnosis of prostate cancer including the issues and controversies regarding screening and early diagnosis. You will also learn about treatment options for different stages of the disease the potential side effects, their management and follow up.

Dr Philip Bergersen completed his medical training at the University of Adelaide and post-fellowship training at Nijmegen University, The Netherlands.

He established a practice in urological surgery at Chatswood and is currently appointed to Sydney Adventist, North Shore Private, Royal North Shore, and Hornsby Hospitals.

Dr Bergersen is an active member of the Multidisciplinary Cancer Team at the San and at Royal North Shore Hospital. He has special interest in urological oncology, stones, BHP and incontinence.

TITLE: WHAT'S NEW IN UROLOGY

Dr Max Dias MBBS, BSc (Med), FRACS (Urol)

Description: You will learn the latest information about the prevention of urological malignancy and be able to identify post radical prostatectomy complications and understand the latest treatments available. You will also gain a basic understanding of the diagnosis and differential diagnosis of a renal mass and the latest treatment options.

Dr Max Dias a Urological Surgeon, completed his medical training at the University of New South Wales. He undertook his post-fellowship urology training at Concord Repatriation and General Hospital in 2007 and 2008, where his focus was on urological cancer, voiding dysfunction and female urology. Dr Dias consults at the San Clinic and at Specialist Services in the Hills district. He is appointed as a VMO at Sydney Adventist Hospital, The Norwest Private Hospital and admits public patients to Hornsby Hospital. His special areas of interest are laparoscopic renal surgery, stone disease and prostate disease.

TITLE: PELVIC FLOOR DYSFUNCTION

Dr Ruth Collins BMBS, BMedSci, MD, FRCS(Urol)(UK), FRACS (Urol)

Description: You will learn about the normal role of the pelvic floor and the causes and effects of pelvic floor dysfunction in urinary incontinence, pelvic pain syndromes and dyspareunia.

Dr Ruth Collins completed her medical training at Nottingham University and all postgraduate training at Newcastle Upon Tyne in the UK. She completed an MD Thesis on "The role of transforming growth factor beta in the benign and malignant prostate." Moving to Sydney in March 2002 she undertook a Urology Fellowship at Concord Hospital, Sydney. In 2003 Dr Collins was appointed as a VMO in Urology at Sydney Adventist Hospital and Concord Hospital.

Her special interests include female urology, voiding dysfunction, urodynamics and management of urinary tract calculi.
